MONITORING OF GEOLOGIC HAZARDS, LONG BEACH UNIT, WILMINGTON OIL FIELD, LOS ANGELES COUNTY

For the purpose of monitoring changes in ground elevation, surveys are being conducted twice each year, February and August, in the onshore area of the Long Beach Subsidence District.

The results of the August 1973 survey substantiates the fact that no subsidence has occurred as the result of operations conducted by the Long Beach Unit.

A network of five stations is being operated for the Long Beach Unit, with the purpose of accurately monitoring seismic activity. Since the last report in June 1973, no earthquakes have been reported by the network within the Long Beach Unit.

The Division will inform the Commission in the event there is any significant change in the above conditions.
