AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION: A .902-acre parcel of submerged land in the Sacramento River near Verona, Sutter County.

Continued maintenance of two floats. LAND USE:

TERMS OF ORIGINAL LEASE: 15 years, from August 8, 1958. Initial period:

Renewal options: 2 additional periods of 10 years each.

WP 2216

A parcel of submerged land lying in the Sacramento River in Sutter County, State of California, adjacent to the SEM of Section 23, T 11 N, R 3 E, MDM, being more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at the intersection of the southerly boundary line of Parcel 1 in that certain deed dated May 19, 1942, from National Company to Natomas Central Mutual Water Company and recorded in Book 218, page 378, Sutter County Official Records, and the east bank of the Sacramento River; thence southeasterly along the east bank of said Sacramento River 1,310 feet, to a point that bears S 42° 56' W, 155 feet from the most southerly corner of Lot 1 as shown on that certain map entitled Natomas Bennett Subdivision, filed in the Office of the County Recorder, Book 3 of Surveys, page 83, Sutter County; thence southwesterly leaving said east bank of the Sacramento River at a right angle 30 feet; thence northwesterly and parallel to said east bank of said Sacramento River 1,310 feet; thence northeasterly and perpendicular to the east bank of said Sacramento River, 30 feet to the point of beginning of this description.

EXCEPTING THEREFROM any portion lying landward of the ordinary low water line.
