4. 49-YEAR PUBLIC AGENCY PERMIT, SUBMERGED LAND IN PETALUMA CREEK NEAR LAKEVILLE, SONOMA COUNTY; CITY OF PETALUMA - W 20554, PRC 4890.9.

After consideration of Calendar Item 2 attached, and upon motion duly made and carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE COMMISSION:

- 1. DETERMINES THAT AN ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT REPORT HAS NOT BEEN PREPARED FOR THIS PROJECT BUT THAT A NEGATIVE DECLARATION HAS BEEN PREPARED BY THE CITY OF PETALUMA, ON FEBRUARY 27, 1974.
- 2. CERTIFIES THAT THE COMMISSION HAS REVIEWED AND CONSIDERED THE INFORMATION CONTAINED IN THE NEGATIVE DECLARATION.
- 3. DETERMINES THAT THE PROJECT WILL NOT HAVE A SIGNIFICANT EFFECT ON THE ENVIRONMENT.
- 4. AUTHORIZES THE ISSUANCE TO THE CITY OF PETALUMA OF A 49-YEAR PUBLIC AGENCY PERMIT FROM APRIL 1, 1974; IN CONSIDERATION OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH AND SAFETY, WITH THE STATE RESERVING THE RIGHT AT ANY TIME TO SET A MONETARY RENTAL IF THE COMMISSION FINDS SUCH ACTION TO BE IN THE STATE'S BEST INTEREST; FOR THE CONSTRUCTION AND MAINTENANCE OF A 42" SEWER OUTFALL LINE ON THE LAND DESCRIBED IN EXHIBIT "A" ATTACHED AND BY REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF; PROVIDED THAT ISSUANCE OF A U. S. CORPS OF ENGINEERS PERMIT SHALL BE A PREREQUISITE TO THIS AUTHORIZATION.

PUBLIC AGENCY PERMIT

APPLICANT: City of Petaluma.

AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION:

A 25,200 square foot parcel of submerged land in Petaluma Creek near Lakeville, Sonoma County.

LAND USE:

Construction and maintenance of a 42" sewer outfall line.

TERM OF PROPOSED LEASE:

Initial period: 49 years, from April 1, 1974.

CONSIDERATION: The public health and safety, with the State reserving the right at any time to set a monetary rental if the Commission

finds such action to be in the State's best interest.

PREREQUISITE TERMS:

Applicant is owner of upland.

STATUTORY AND OTHER REFERENCES:

a. Public Resources Code: Div. 6, Parts 1 and 2.

b. Administrative Code: Title 2, Div. 3, Arts. 1, 2 and

10.

c. Administrative Code: Title 14, Div. 6, Sec. 15083.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. The annual rental value of the site is estimated to be \$100.
- 2. Environmental data for this project has been circulated to appropriate agencies by the applicant under State Clearinghouse Number 71102529. In the absence of adverse comment, the City of Petaluma has executed a negative declaration. The State Lands Division has reviewed the environmental data accompanying the negative declaration and concurs in the applicant's findings.

Under current procedures, the Corps of Engineers withholds issuance of its permit until State agencies approve the project. The proposed permit will require the applicant to obtain clearance from the Corps.
