After consideration of Calendar Item 34 attached, and upon motion duly made

APPROVAL OF SURVEY AND MAPS OF THE LOW WATER LINE
OF CLEAR LAKE, LAKE COUNTY

Clear Lake is a natural, navigable lake, the bed of which is owned by the State of California and was under the jurisdiction of the State Lands Commission (Civil Code Section 670 and Public Resources Code Section 6301) until granted to the County of Lake by Chapter 639, Statutes of 1973. Through public and court usage, an elevation of Zero on the Rumsey Gage has been accepted as the low water line of Clear Lake, although no legislative action or court adjudication to that effect has been made.

In 1964, the California Legislature by Senate and Assembly Concurrent Resolutions (Chapters 58 and 77, First Extraordinary Session of 1964) requested the State Lands Commission to survey the low water mark of Clear Lake, in Lake County.

The subject maps, consisting of 68 sheets entitled "MAP OF THE LOW WATER LINE OF CLEAR LAKE", have been prepared in response to the Senate and Assembly Concurrent Resolutions.

The low water line shown on this set of maps represents a survey of the line of Zero Rumsey Gage elevation as it existed at the time of the State Lands Division survey, unless otherwise noted.

The line of Zero Rumsey Gage was surveyed at an elevation of 1,318.26 feet above Sea Level Datum of 1929, based on the latest National Geodetic Survey level adjustment for the Clear Lake area published November, 1968, and also based on the sea level elevation of the center of a concrete star reference mark in the northeast corner of Courthouse Park in Lakeport which mark is 20.1 feet above Rumsey Gage Zero.
