PARCEL 1:

All that nortion of the north half of Section 6, T 17 N, R 1 E, MDM, as shown on the U. S. Township Plat approved January 3. 1856, lying westerly of the westerly boundary lines of the U. S. Subdivision Lots 7 and 8, and lying easterly of the easterly boundary lines of said Subdivision Lots 1 and 2.

PAPCEL 2:

All that portion of the north half of Section 18, T 17 N, R 1 E, MDM, as shown on said plat, lying westerly of the westerly boundary lines of the U. S. Subdivision Lots 7 and 8 and easterly of the easterly boundary lines of said Subdivision Lots 1 and 2.

EXTEPTING THEREFROM any portion of Parcels 1 and 2 lying landward of the ordinary low water mark.
