- Lease was issued on January 30, 1964 to 1. Stanley E. Ryerson and Fredrick E. Pinner, on 80 acres in Imperial County for the extraction of sand and gravel.
- The lease gave the Lessees the right to renew the lease for 2 successive 5-year periods. The final 5-year period was authorized by the State Lands Commission on February of 1974 and the lease will expire on January 28, 1979.

- 3. To date, the lease has produced approximately 266,405 cubic yards of sand and gravel, yielding rojalties of approximately \$38,996 to the State.
- 4. Current royalty rate is \$0.2218 cents per cubic yard and the minimum annual production shall te 7500 cubic yards.
- 5. Production for Fiscal Year 1974-1975 has been limited to the minimum, due mainly to market conditions.

The lease has produced both sand and gravel in the past; however, future production will probably be limited primarily to sand since most of the gravel has been extracted.
