RENEWAL OF PUBLIC AGENCY LEASE

APPL-ICANT:

The United States of Amorica

AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION:

A 15,242.54 acre parcel of State school land, near Herlong, Lassen County,

LAND USE:

Military (Sierra Army Pepot).

TERMS OF ORIGINAL LEASE:

Initial period:

From February 1, 1942 to June

Renewal options: 2 successive periods of 10 year each.

Consideration: \$1,829.10 per annum.

TERMS OF RENEWAL:

Renewal period: 10 years from July 1, 1975. CONSIDERATION: \$1,829.10 ptr annum.

BASIS FOR CONSIDERATION:

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\$.12 per acre. Rent to remain the same as in original lease pursuant to terms of said lease, OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

1. This project is not situated on State land identified as environmentally significant, pursuant to Public Resources Code 6370.1, and is not classified in a significant use

- 2. An Environmental Impact Report is not required. This transaction is within the pur-view of 2 Cal. Adm. Code 2907(a) which exempts an existing structure or facility that is in an acceptable state of repair and there is no evidence of record to show injury to adjacent property, shoreline erosion, or other types of environmental degradation.
- The State Lands Commission, at its April 28, 3. 1950 meeting, adopted a resolution authorizing the Executive Officer to execute a lease with the United States of American for approxi-mately 15,500 acres of State school land within the Sierra Ordinance Depot in Lassen

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County. The lease was prepared by the United States of America.

The subject lease specifically provides for renewal, at the option of the Lessee, for two additional 10-year periods, on the same terms and conditions as provided in the lease for the initial period. Staff Counsel is of the option that the subject lease cannot be altered or amended. Further, staff counsel is of the opinion that acceptance of the Notice of Renewal of Leases (Exhibit C), as prepared by the U. S. Corps of Engineers for the United States of America, is legal and proper.

AUTHORIZE THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER OR HIS DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE A NOTICE OF RENEWAL OF LEASE PRC 514, IN THE FORM OF EXHIBIT "C" ON ELLE IN THE OFFICE OF THE STATE LANDS COMMISSION AND BY REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF, BETWEEN THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA AND THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA, STATE LANDS COMMISSION OF A 10-YEAR RENEWAL OF A PUBLIC AGENCY LEASE FROM JULY 1, 1975, IN GONSIDERATION OF ANNUAL RENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,829.10 FOR THE OPERATION, CONTINUANCE AND MAINTENANCE OF THE SIERRA ARMY DEPOT, NEAR HERLONG, ON THE LAND DESCRIBED ON EXHIBIT "A" ATTACHED AND BY REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF.
