PUBLIC AGENCY PERMIT

APPLICANT:

City of Union City 1154 Whipple Road

Union City, California 94587

AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION:

An 0.327 acre parcel in the original bed of Alameda Creek, City of Union City, Alameda County.

LAND USE:

Construction and maintenance of a divided four-lane road.

TERMS OF PROPOSED LEASE:

Initial period: 49 years, from April 1, 1976.

CONSIDERATION:

The public use and benefit, with the State reserving the right at any time to set a monetary rental if the Commission finds such action to be in the State's best interest.

PREREQUISITE TERMS, FEES AND EXPENSES:

Applicant is owner of upland.

Filing fee and processing costs have been received.

STATUTORY AND OTHER REFERENCES:

A. Public Resources Code: Div. 6, Parts 1 & 2.

B. Administrative Code: Title 2, Div. 3, Arts. 1, 2, 10 & 11.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- l. The annual rental value of the site is estimated to be \$600.
- 2. This project is not situated on State land identified as environmentally significant, pursuant to Public Resources Code 6370.1, and is not classified in a significant use category. A negative declaration was prepared by the City of Union City pursuant to CEQA and implementing regulations. A Notice of Determination has been received.

A parcel of land in the State owned bed of Alameda Creek in its natural location in the City of Union City, Alameda County, State of California, also lying within that right-of-way shown on that certain map entitled "Right-of-Way Record Map, Union City Boulevard" filed in Book 73; at Pages 67 through 73 of Miscellaneous Maps; Alameda County Recorders Office; said parcel is more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point on the westerly right-of-way of Union City Boulevard, said point being located westerly of the intersection of the centerlines of Union City Boulevard and Smith Street, said point also being the beginning of a curve concave to the west from a tangent bearing N 01° 25' 07" W; thence northwesterly along said curve of right-of-way, having a radius of 945 feet through a central angle of 21° 35' 36", an arc distance of 356.15 feet; thence along said westerly right-of-way, N 23 00' 43" W 171.44 feet; thence leaving said westerly right-of-way N 66° 59' 17" E 110 feet to a point on the easterly right-of-way of Union City Boulevard; thence along said easterly right-of-way, S 23° 00 43" E 171.44; thence continuing along said easterly right-of-way, on a curve concave to the west having a radius of 1055 feet, through a central angle of 16° 55' 13", an arc distance of 311.56 feet; thence leaving said easterly rightof way S 49° 40' 28" W 136.85 feet to the point of beginning.

EXCEPTING THEREFROM any portion lying landward of the ordinary high water mark of Alameda Creck (in its natural location).

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
