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MAINTENANCE DREDGING OPERATION

DAG PRC 5129

APPLICANT:

Santa Clara County Department of Public Works 70 West Hedding Street San Jose, California 95110

PROPOSED DREDGING:

To perform maintenance dredging of 90,000 cubic yards within the water area, on tide and submerged land (approximately 7 acres), in the marina at Alviso, as described on attached Exhibit "A", Santa Clara County,

SPOIL PLACEMENT: The sediments are to be removed by hydraulic dredging and transported by means of a pipe-line to a 23 acre disposal site behind dikes on Santa Clara County Park lands located adjacent to Guadalupe Slough and Calabazas Creek.

PURPOSE:

For continued operation of a public marina.

CONSIDERATION:

The public benefit; no royalty required.

ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT CONSIDERATION:

- An Environmental Impact Report is not required. This project is within the purview of 2 Cal. Adm. Code 2910(a), Class 4, which exempts a maintenance dredging operation.
- This project is situated on State land identified as possessing significant environmental values, pursuant to Public Resources Code 6370.1, and is classified in a significant use category, Class C: Multiple Use. Staff review indicates that there will be no significant effect upon the identified environmental values. The staff of the Division has received no adverse comments on this project.

OTHER PERTINENT DATA:

- The proposed dredge area was last dredged in 1967 under the previous Dredging Permit 1. PRC 3606.
- The sediments are to be removed by hydraulic dredging.

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## CALHNDAR ITHM NO. C14 (CONTD)

- Waste Discharge Requirements, Order No. 76-13, governing both the drodging and wastewater overflow that will be discharged from the disposal area into Guada-Tupe Slough, were adopted by the California Regional Water Quality Control Board on Rebruary 17, 1976.
  - The Department of Fish and Game, in responding to the Bay Conservation and Development Commission, had no objection to this project.
    - This permit will be issued contingent upon the applicant's securing a Corps of Engineers Permit and a Regional Water Quality Control Board Certificate of Conformance.
      - Effective period of the permit to be May 27, 1976, to December 31, 1976. 6.
