(2) It is an express condition of this permit that if any structure or appurtenances hereby authorized are found to be situated upon or adjacent to land of the County of Placer without their consent and approval, then this permit is automatically terminated, effective upon notice by the State, and the site shall be cleared pursuant to the tarms herein. a supplement to Paragraph 6 of Section 5, Permittee hereby agrees that when the State's boundaries are established, the State has the right to revise the rate and amount of the annual rental in addition to the rights stated in Paragraph 2 of Section 5 hereof; together with the right to approve existing improvements and fills in place.
