AREA; TYPE LAND AND LOCATION:

An 0.234 acre parcel, tide and submerged land, Sacramento River, Andrus Island, Sacramento County.

LAND USE:

Continued operation and maintenance of existing pile dolphins and barge loading facilities.

TERMS OF ORIGINAL LEASE:

Initial period: 15 years, from November 20,

Renewal options: 2 successive periods of 10

years each.

Surety bond:

\$4,000.

Consideration:

\$50.

TERMS OF PROPOSED RENEWAL

Renewal period:

10 years, from November 20,

1975

Surety bond;

\$1,000.

Public Trability insurance: \$300,000 combined single limit for bodily in-

jury and property damage.

CONSIDERATION:

\$450 per annum, with the State reserving the right to fix a different rental on each fifth anniversary of the lease.

BASIS FOR CONSIDERATION:

\$450 minimum rental for this type of lease or permit.

PREREQUISITE TERMS, FEES AND EXPENSES: Applicant is owner of upland.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- This project is situated on State land identified as possessing significant environmental values, pursuant to Public Resources Code 6370.1, and is chassified in a significant use category, Class B.
- Staff review indicates that there will be no significant effect upon the identified environmental values. This is an existing facility for which no adverse comments have been received.
- An Environmental Impact Report is not required. This transaction is within the purview of 2 Cal. Adm. Code 2907(a) which exempts in existing structure or facility that is in an acceptable state of repair and there is no evidence of record to show injury to adjacent property, shoreline grosion, or other types of environmenta, degradation.
