USE PERMIT

APPLICANT:

David C. Sargent

AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION:

A 2340 square foot parcel of submerged land in Lake Tahoe near Idlewild, Placer County.

LAND USE:

Existing recheational pier.

TERMS OF PROPOSED LEASE:

Initial period: 5 years, from January 1, 1975.

Surety bond:

\$2,000.

CONSIDERATION:

\$75 per annum. The consideration is based upon Anticle 2, Cal. Adm. Code, in effect at

the date of construction.

BASIS FOR CONSIDERATION:

\$75 fixed rental for this type of lease or

permit.

PREREQUISITE TERMS, FEES AND EXPENSES:

Applicant is permittee of upland. Filing fee and 2 years' rent has been received.

STATUTORY AND OTHER REFERENCES!

Public Resources Code: Div. 6, Parts 1 & 2. A.,

Administrative Code: Title 2, Div. 3, Arts. 1, 2, 10 & 11.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- The State's former permittee sold his interest to the proposed permittee on January 1, 1975. The upland owner, U.S. Forest Service, has issued a permit to the proposed permittee, effective through December 31, 1979. State's permit will be effective only so long as permittee has upland owner permission to utilize upland area.
- State's permit will specify that should any structure be found in nonconformance with the Tahoe Regional Planning Agency's Shorezone Ordinance, including needed

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repairs, alterations or removal pursuant to said Ordinance, the State's permit will be automatically terminated.

- 3. An Environmental Impact Report is not required. This transaction is within the purview of 2 Cal. Adm. Code 2907(a) which exempts a pier, floating dock or boathouse, restricted to noncommercial or recreational use that will occupy no more than 3,000 square feet of tide and submerged lands, including the area of use.
- 4. This project is situated on State land identified as possessing significant environmental values, pursuant to Public Resources Gode 6370.1, and is classified in a significant use category, Class B. Limited Use.

Staff review indicates that there will be no significant effect upon the identified environmental values. This is an existing facility for which no adverse comments have been received.

SARGENT OF A 5-YEAR USE PERMIT FROM JANUARY 1, 1975; IN CONSIDERATION OF ANNUAL RENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$75; WITH PROVISION OF A \$2,000 SURETY BOND; FOR AN EXISTING RECREATIONAL PIER ON THE LAND DESCRIBED ON EXHIBIT "A" ATTACHED AND BY REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF.

WP 4240

A strip of land 26 feet wide lying in the State owned bed of Take Tahoe, Placer County, California, and adjacent to fractional Section 25, TI5N, RISE, M.D.M. The centerline of said strip being described as follows:

COMMENCING at Station 97 as shown on sheet 6 of those maps entitled "Survey of the Low Water Mark on the Shore of Lake Tahoe" recorded in Book 2 of Surveys, at Page 71, Official Records of Placer County; thence S 10° 00' 53" W 170.0 feet to the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING; thence N 71° 56' 32" E 170.0 feet to the point of termination.

EXCEPTING THEREFROM any portion lying landward of the ordinary high water mark of Lake Tahoc.
