AUTHORIZATION FOR EXECUTION OF A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN SAN FRANCISCO BAY CONSERVATION AND DEVELOPMENT COMMISSION AND THE STATE LANDS COMMISSION

In order to comply fully with the requirements of the Federal Coastal Zone Management Act of 1972, the Office of Coastal Zone Management has recommended that the San Francisco Bay Conservation and Development Commission, through memorandum of understanding, document its relationship with various State agencies, including the State Lands Commission.

The proposed Memorandum of Understanding with BCDC is intended to describe the existing working relationship between BCDC and the State Lands Commission. Its key provisions are:

- 1. BCDC will request the comments of the State Lands Commission on all major permits and on the administrative permit last, and not issue a permit until comments are received (except where the 90-day time limit would require the Bcd Commission to act).
- 2. Where questions of the extent of State ownership exist, BCDC will not issue a permit until the ownership question has been resolved. (This is an existing requirement of both the McAteer-Petris Act and BCDC's regulations).

IT IS HEREBY RECOMMENDED THAT THE STATE LANDS COMMISSION AUTHORIZE THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER TO EXECUTE A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH THE SAN FRANCISCO BAY CONSERVATION AND DEVELOPMENT COMMISSION.
