LAND USE:

Existing pipeline for domestic water, existing pier and one float for recreational boating.

TERMS OF PROPOSED LEASE:

Initial period: 5 years from January 1, 1975.

Surety bond:

\$1,000.

CONSIDERATION:

\$75 per annum prorated thru June 29, 1975, and \$100 per annum thereafter.

Fixed rental for this type of lease or permit.

The County of Placer claims the immediate

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- The State's permit will specify that should any structure be found in non-conformance with the Tahoe Regional Planning Agency's Shoreline Ordinance, including needed repairs, alterations or removal pursuant to said Ordinance, the State's permit will be automatically terminated.
- It is an express condition of this permit that if any structure or appurtenances hereby authorized are found to be situated upon or adjacent to land of the County of Placer, without their consent and approval, then this permit is automatically terminated, effective

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upon notice by the State, and the site shall be cleared pursuant to the terms herein.

- 3. An Environmental Impact Report is not required. This transaction is within the purview of 2 Cal, Adm. Code 2907 (a) which exempts a pier, floating dock or boathouse, restricted to non-commercial or recreational use that with occupy no more than 3,000 square feet of tide and submerged lands, including the area of use.
- This project is situated on State land identified as possessing significant environmental values, pursuant to Public Resources Gode 6370.1, and is classified in a significant use category, Class B: Limited Use.

Staff review indicates that there will be no significant effect upon the identified environmental values. This is an existing facility for which no adverse comments have been received.
