An Environmental Impact Report is not re-OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION: quired. This transaction is within the purview of 2 Cal. Adm. code 2907(a) which exempts an existing structure or Eacility that is in an acceptable state of mepair and there is no evidence of record to show injury to aujacent property, shore line erosion, of other types of environmental degradation.

This project is situated on State Land identified as possessing significant environmental values, punsuant to Public 2 .. Resources Code 6370.1, and is classified in a significant use category, Class B, which authorizes limited use.

Staff review indicates that there will be no significant effect upon the identified environmental values. Thas is an existing facultity for which no adverse comments have been received.

These marina facilities have not been actively operated commercially since the 1972 Andrus Island flood. Although the 3. facilities are in an acceptable state of repair, they are not in sufficient repair to allow immediate use commercially. Therefore the staff has included in the proposed lease a special provision which allows the lessee's five years to renovate the marina facilities and bring them to standard acceptable to the U.S. Anny Corps of Engineers.

Should lessee fail to complete renovation within the five year period then the State Lands Commission could terminate the hease and require removal of existing structure at lessce's sole expense.
