REVISION IN LEASE RUNTAL AFTER ROUTING REVIEW

This is a Right-of-Way Lease for a term of 49-years from February 1, 1972, with an existing annual rent of \$20, covering an 0.11 acre parcel of submerged land in the Sacramento River near Colusa, Colusa County, for the construction and maintenance of a three-wire 12 KV overhead transmission line.

The lease listed below provides that the State may adjust the annual rental at a different amount for the 5-year term following the fifth anniversary of the lease, effective on such anniversary date.

The value of the land covered by the lease has been considered and it has been determined that the minimum rental rate should apply. The lessee was notified of the amount within the time constraints set by his lease.
