12 circular parcels 40 feet in diameter totalling 0.35 acres of tide and submerged land in the bed of the San Joaquin River offshore of Tinsley Island, San Joaquin County.

LANĎ USE: Continued maintenance of 12 existing buoys and associated anchors.

Initial period: 10 years from October 1, 1976.

AUTHORFZE ISSUANCE TO SAINT FRANCIS YACHT GLUB OF A 10-YEAR NONCOMMERCIAL LEASE FROM OCTOBER 1, 1976; IN CONSIDERA-TION OF ANNUAL RENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$225 PER ANNUM, WITH THE STATE RESERVING THE RIGHT TO FIX A DIEFERENT RENTAL ON EACH FIFTH ANNIVERSARY OF THE LEASE; PROVISION OF A \$500 SURETY BOND; FOR THE CONTINUED MAINTENANCE OF 12 EXISTING FLOATING BUOYS AND ASSOCIATED ANCHORS ON THE LAND DESCRIBED ON EXHIBIT "A" ATTACHED AND BY REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF.
