2. This project is situated on State land identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to Public Resources Code 6370.1 and is classified in a use category, Class A which authorizes Restricted Use.

Staff review indicates that there will be no significant effect upon the identified environmental values. This is an existing facility for which no adverse comments have been received.

On January 7, 1977, Simpson Lee Paper Company was merged into Simpson Lee Holding Company (a wholly owned subsidiary of Simpson Timber Company); as part of the Plan of Merger, the name of the surviving corporation was changed to Simpson Paper Company.
