The notice was based on the assumption that the Federal Energy Administration (FEA) the assumptions would not extend the term of the Royalty Oil regulations would not extend the term of the Royalty Oil sales Contract with World Oil Company under which the Sales Contract with World Oil from these leases, State sells the royalty oil from these leases.

World confested the State's interpretation of the Federal regulations and solicited advice from the FEA. The FEA's regulations and solicited advice from the FEA. The FEA's informal advice was that there was a sound basis for World's informal advice was that there was a sound basis for World's claim of a valid supplier/purchaser relationship (which would extend the existing contract for the duration of the FEA extend the existing contract for the duration of the State would program) for the State's royalty oil and that the State would be wise to continue delivering the oil to World.

Based on these representations from the FEA and World's agreement to hold the State harmless against any damages sustained by Union as a result of the State's continued sustained by Union as a result of the Executive Officer sustained by Union as a result of the Executive Officer sustained by Union as a result of the Executive Officer sustained the notification of November 1, 1976, and advised the notification of November 1, 1976, and advised Union that the State will continue to deliver its royalty.
