AREA, TYPE LAND AND BOCATION: A 38 x 82' (0.072 acre) parcel of navigable submerged land in the san Joaquin River, Stanislaus County.

LAND USE:

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Construct and maintain a 30" drainage pipeline outfall and rock rip rap bank protection.

TERMS OF PROPOSED LEASE:

initial period: 49 years from July 1; 1977.

CONSIDERATION: The public health and safety.

PREREQUISITE TERMS, FEES AND EXPENSES: Applicant is permittee of upland.
