AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION: A circular parcel of submerged land in the San Pedro Channel, southeasterly of Long Boint, Los Angeles County:

LAND USE:

The placement and operation of an ocean monitoring buoy to provide continuous monitoring of meanshore conditions for forecasting the meed for chlorination of treated wastewater.

TERMS OF PROPOSED LEASE: Initial period:

10 years, from August 1, 1977.
