LAND USE:

. Construct supplement to existing storm water drainage outfall and dissipator.

TERMS OF PROPOSED LEASE:

Initial period: 49 years, from July 1,

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- The annual rental value of the site is estimated to be \$100.
- The proposed project is the reconstruction 2. and minor modification of a storm water drainage outfall which has existed at this location for some time.

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- 3. An Environmental Impact Report is not required. This transaction is within the purview of 2 Cal. Adm. Code 2907, Class 1B, which exempts a minor alteration or modification of an existing facility.
- 4. This project is situated on State land identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to Public Resources Code 6307.1, and is classified in a use category, Class A which authorizes Restricted Use.

Staff has coordinated this project with those agencies and organizations who nominated the site as containing significant environmental values. They mave found this project to be compatible with their nomination.

5. Applicant has applied for permits from the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers and the State Reclamation Board. Permit has been issued by the State Department of Fish and Game.
