## AUTHORIZATION TO ENTER INTO AN INTERACENCY AGREEMENT WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF PARKS AND RECREATION

The State Lands Division has been requested by the Department of Parks and Recreation to make a determination of the extent of State interest in the bed of a reach of the Upper Sacramento River. Partial funding of \$75,000 for boundary determination activities in the specified area is to be provided by the Department of Parks and Recreation with the remainder to be provided by the State Lands Division in the form of supervision and support;

The site to be studied is within an Area Project and one considered to be of significant value as part of a river recreation corridor from Red Bluff to Colusa. The site will be specifically used as a stopover on a canoe trail. Staff anticipates that this project will take two years to complete. The exact limits of the project area will be determined jointly by staff and by the funding agency.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION AUTHORI'S THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER TO ENTER INTO AN INTERAGENCY SERVICE AGREEMENT WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF PARKS AND RECREATION ENABLING THE STATE LANDS DIVISION TO RECEIVE FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$75,000 FOR BOUNDARY DETERMINATION IN AND ALONG THE SACRAMENTO RIVER IN GLENN AND BUTTE COUNTLES; PROJECT IS EXPECTED ANTICIPATED IN AUGUST, 1980.
