GENERAL PERMIT PUBLIC ACENCY USE

APPLICANT:

Sacramento Regional County Sanitation District

827 Seventh Street, Room 304 Sacramento, California 95814

AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION:
A 200 \* 200 (.918 acre) parcel of tide and submerged land in the Sacramento River, Sacramento County.

LAND USE:

Construction and maintenance of additions to an existing wastewater outfall structure.

TERMS OF PROPOSED PERMIT:

Initial period: 49 years from October 1, 1977.

COMSIDERATION:

The public health and safety, with the State reserving the right at any cime to set a monetary rental if the Commission finds such action to be in the State's best interest.

PREREQUISITÉ TERMS, FEES AND EXPENSES:

Applicant is owner of upland.

Processing costs have been received.

STATUTORY AND OTHER REFERENCES:

A. Public Resources Code: Div. 6, Parts 1 & 2.

Administrative Code: Tirle 2, Div. 3, Arts. 1, 2, 10, & 11.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- The annual rental value of the site is estimated to be \$800.
- A final Environmental Impact Report was prepared by the Sacramento Regional County Sanitation District, pursuant to CEQA and implementing regulations.

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## CALENDAR ITEM NO. C 3 (CONTD)

A Notice of Depermination has been received.

This project is situated on State land identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to Public Resources Code 6370.1; and is classified in a use category, Class B which authorizes Limited Use.

Staff has coordinated this project with those agencies and organizations who nominated the site as containing significant environmental values. They have found this project to be compatible with their nomination.

As a part of the County-City joint project to upgrade wastewater treatment and disposal, the Sacramento Regional County Sanitation District was formed. The District has prepared a master plan and appropriate environmental documents covering the proposed reconstruction of existing facilities and the construction of new facilities under a project entitled "Combined Wastewater Control System" in order to meet statewide water quality standards. The master plan and environmental document have been reviewed by staff and were found to b sufficient. This permit covers a proposed reconstruction of an existing outfall, which was not under permit in the past, to make the outfall more efficient in order to eliminate older facilities.

## FURTHER APPROVALS REQUIRED:

Applicant indicates the following permits are required for the project: Regional Water Quality Control Board, Reclamation Board, Fish & Game, Corps of Engineers. No other permits have been issued at this time.
