- This project is structed on State land identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to Public Resources Code 6370.1, and is classified in a use category, Class "G", Multiple Use.
- The applicant advises that the proposed project is compatible with the land use on adjacent parcels. Gradings will be minimal. The project will not significantly disturb the natural biotic habitat. There are no archaelogical resources on the project site.

The staff concludes that the project will not have any significant effects on those characteristics identified under Public Resources Code 6370.1.
