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OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- These facilities had existed for some time prior to August 1974 when the staff became aware of them through the United States Army Corps of Engineer's public notice system. The Corr's notice was issued for the existing facilities and a proposed new floating dock. The new dock was never constructed.
- 2. No back rent has been requested. It is not a staff practice to recommend back rent from new owners of facilities which had never been under lease. These facilities were purchased by the proposed lessee in February, 1.77. The new owner has signed proposed lease documents and paid the first year's rental,
- 3. An EIR is not required. This transaction is within the purview of 2 Cal. Adm. Code 2907, Class 1B, which exempts an existing structure or facility that is in an acceptable state of repair and there is no evidence of record to show injury to adjacent property, shoreline erosion, or other types of envisonmental degradation.
- 4. This project is situated on State land identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to Public Resources Code 6370.1, and is classified in a use category, Class B which authorizes Limited Use.

Staff review indicates that there will be no significant effect upon the identified environmental values. This is an existing facility for which no adverse comments have been received.
