LAND USE:

Reconstruction of 1 pier and the placement and maintenance of 2 mooring buoys, respectively, for recreational boating.

TERMS OF PROPOSED PERMIT:

The permit is conditioned on permittee's conformance with the Tahoe Regional Planning Agency's Shorezone Ordinance.

2. The permit is entered into by all parties without prejudice to their respective claims of boundary.

OTHER PURTINENT LAYORMATION:

- The issuance of Use Permit, PRC 5113.1 to Stanley Hiller, Jr., for 1 pier was authorized by the Commission on April 28, 1976 (Minute Item No. 4). Applicant now desires to reconstruct the pier and to place 2 mooring buoys for his future enjoyment of a greater recreational benefit adjacent to his littoral land.
- 2. An EIR is not required. This transaction is within the purview of 2 Cal. Adm. Code 2907, Class 3A and 3C which exempt construction of small structures, and small boat mooring buoys not used for commercial purposes, respectively.

CALENDAR ITEM NO. C15. (CONED)
