land in the Colorado River, San Bernardino

County.

LAND USE:

Maintenance of an existing dock and two

8-foot fences.

TERMS OF PROPOSED PERMIT:

Initial period:

10 years from February 1,

1978.

Insurance:

\$100,000 combined single rimit for bodily injury

and property damage.

CONSIDERATION:

\$40 per annum, with the State reserving the right to fix a different rental on

each fifth anniversary of the permit.

BASIS FOR CONSIDERATION:

\$40 fixed rental for this type of permit.

PREREOUISITU TERMS, FEES AND EXPENSES:

Applicant is lessee of upland.

Filing fee and first year's rental have

been received.

STATUTORY AND OTHER REFERENCES:

A. Public Resources Code: Div. 6, Parts 1 & 2.

B. Administrative Code: Title 2, Pav. 3,

Arts. 1, 2, 10 & 11.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

1. An EIR is not required. This transaction is within the purview of 2 Cal. Adm.

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Code 2907, Class 1B, which exempts an existing structure or facility that is in an acceptable state of repair and there is no evidence of record to show injury to adjacent property, shoreline erosion, or other types of environmental degradation.

 This project is situated on State land identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to Public Resources Code 6370.1, and is classified in a use category, Class B which authorizes Limited Use.

Staff review indicates that there will be no significant effect upon the identified environmental values. This is an existing facility for which no alverse comments have been received.

2 fences are maintained to contain his dogs. The fences extend to the water's edge and are on dry land except during periods of extremely high water. Said fences pose less of an interference with public easement than the existing dock.
