AMENDMENT OF LEASE PRC 5468.1 AND AUTHORIZATION PO SEND VOLUMETRIC RENTAL IMPOUND LETTER

The Commission at its meeting on April 27, 1978, approved and commission at its meeting on april a for Pacific Gas and Electric's (PG&E's) proposed expansion of their Moss Landing Marine Terminal (PRC 5468.1).

The loase has a beginning date of January 1, 1978, and requires construction to begin by November 1, 1978. Because of the delay in completing the environmental documents of the delay in completing the environmental documents for the project and anticipated delays in obtaining all other regulatory approvals near that the other regulatory approvals Fight has requested that the lease beginning date be modified. Small is recommending that the lease beginning date remain unchanged but is requesting Commission approval to modify the construction limiting dates to allow PG&E sufficient time to obtain all necessary regulatory approvals for the project.

Staff is also seeking Commission authority to send PG&E a letter detailing the impounding of volumetric rental in excess of the minimum rental and the distribution of said impounded rentals pending final resolution of the existing litigation. PGSE has requested that such a letter
