AUTHORIZATION TO FILE DISCLAIMER IN  
CITY OF SACRAMENTO V. ARTZ & COOK, ET AL.,  
SACRAMENTO COUNTY SUPERIOR COURT NO. 273884.

The State Lands Commission is a party to a City of Sacramento condemnation action brought by the City Attorney entitled City of Sacramento v. Artz & Cook, et al., filed in the Sacramento County Superior Court, Civil No. 273884, involving land in Sacramento County to be used in connection with realignment of the Garden Highway.

Upon examination of the Commission's records pertinent to the area, it has been ascertained that there is no interest held by the State Lands Commission as to the tract of land described in the notice of condemnation.

Inasmuch as this suit involves land over which the Commission has no jurisdiction, it is recommended that a disclaimer be filed on behalf of the State Lands Commission disclaiming any compensable right, title or interest in the tract of the subject condemnation.


