Applicant is owner of upland.

Filing fee has been received.

an existing structure or facility that is in an acceptable state of repair and there is no evidence of record to show injury to adjacent property shoreline erosion, or other types of environmental degradation.

2. This project is situated on State land identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370.1, and is classified in a use category, Class B, which authorizes Limited Use.

Staff has coordinated this project with those agencies and organizations who nominated the site as containing significant environmental values. They have found this project to be compatible with their nomination.

- 3. A coastal zone permit was approved by the North Central Regional Coastal Commission at its meeting on December 1, 1977.
- 4. This project has been reviewed and found acceptable by the Tomales Bay Study Group which is composed of staff from the State Lands Commission, Marin County and North Central Regional Coastal Commission.

California Department of Fish and Game, United States Army Corps of Engineers, Coastal Commission, California Regional Water Quality Control Board, United States Fish and Wildlife, Marin County and United States Coast Guard.



LAND DESCRIPTION

A parcel of tide and submerged land in the bed of Tomales Bay, Marin County, California, said parcel being immediately beneath a wharf, TOGETHER WITH a necessary use area extending no more than 10 feet from said wharf, said wharf being adjacent to that land described in that Individual Joint Tenancy Deed, recorded April 23, 1969, in Book 2291, page 44, Official Records of Marin County.

EXCEPTING THEREFROM any portion lying landward of the ordinary high water mark of Tomales Bay.

SUBJECT TO those interests-in-land, if any, which may have passed by virtue of Tideland Survey No. 233, Marin County, patented February 19, 1947, to James W. Cochrane.
