RECISSION OF PERMIT PRC 3257.1
ISSUANCE OF 10-YEAR RECREATIONAL PIER PERMIT

AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION:
A 0.169 acre parcel of submerged lands
in Lake Tahoe at Carnelian Bay, Placer
County.

LAND USE: Maintenance of 1 existing pier for recreational
boating.

TERMS OF ORIGINAL PERMIT:
Initial period: 10 years from July 1,
1976.

Public liability insurance: \$400,000 per
occurrence for bodily
injury and \$100,000 for
property damage, or combined
single limit coverage
of \$500,000.

Consideration: \$591.69 from July 1,
1976 through June 30,
1979; and \$130 per annum
thereafter.

Special: 1. The permit is conditioned
on permittee's confor-
mance with the Tahoe
Regional Planning Agency's
Shorezone Ordinance.

2. The permit is conditioned
on the County of Placer's
authorization and consent

3. The permit is issued without prejudice to the respective claims of all parties' boundaries.

TERMS OF PROPOSED PERMIT:

Initial period: 10 years from May 16, 1978.

Special: 1. The permit is conditioned on permittee's conformance with the Tahoe Regional Planning Agency's Shorezone Ordinance.

CONSIDERATION: The public benefit pursuant to P.R.C. 6503.

BASIS FOR CONSIDERATION:

2 Cal. Adm. Code 2005.

PREREQUISITE TERMS, FEES AND EXPENSES:

Applicants are owners of upland.

Filing fee and processing costs have been received.

STATUTORY AND OTHER REFERENCES:

A. P.R.C: Div. 6, Parts 1 & 2.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:


