DENIAL OF APPLICATIONS
(AB 884)

Pursuant to Chapter 1200, Statutes of 1977 (AB 884) the following applications for State Lands Commission lease or permit are submitted for denial. 2. AUTHORIZE STAFF TO ADVISE EACH APPLICANT OF THE COMMISSION'S ACTION TO DENY AND OF THE APPLICANT'S RIGHT TO REAPPLY FOR A PERMIT.
