AUTHORIZATION TO OFFER A LEASE FOR
EXTRACTION OF SAND AND GRAVEL

AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION:

Approximately 513 acres of submerged land
West of Alcatraz Island in San Francisco
Bay, San Francisco County.

PROPOSAL:

The proposal involves hydraulically dredging
sand at the rate of 100,000 cubic yards
per year and off-loading at various points
as needed. The State lands will be leased
pursuant to competitive bid.

TERMS OF PROPOSED LEASE:

1. The proposed lease is for a primary
term of 5 years with the option to
renew for 1 period of 5 years upon
such reasonable terms and conditions
as may be prescribed by the State.
2. The royalty shall be according to the
following schedule:

$$R = (0.10 W (Y))B$$

Where R = Royalty in dollars and cents
paid to the State, and

W = Weighted average lease-quarter
sales price, f.o.b. the dock,
per cubic yard, and

Y = Total lease-quarter cubic
yardage sold.

B = Bid Factor which shall be
no less than 1.0.

The annual minimum extraction volume
shall be 50,000 cubic yards. The minimum
royalty per cubic yard shall not be
less than \$0.30.

APPROVAL OBTAINED:

In accordance with Section 6818 of the PRC, the State Director of Parks and Recreation was notified of the proposed lease and has determined that the project will have no significant interference with recreational use of lands littoral to the tide and submerged lands involved in the proposed lease area.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

1. Area is known to contain commercially valuable sand and gravel deposits.
2. The Commission staff in accordance with Article 10, Section 2905(b) of the Cal. Adm. Code, has conducted an Initial Study and has determined that the project will not have a significant effect on the environment. Therefore, in compliance with Section 2905(c) of the Cal. Adm. Code, a Negative Declaration was prepared and filed with the State Clearinghouse.

The Negative Declaration was circulated to responsible agencies and agencies having jurisdiction by law. None of the agencies had any comments.

Negative Declaration No. 250 which covers this project was certified as being completed in compliance with CEQA of 1970, as amended, by the State Lands Commission on October 29, 1979.

3. Project is situated on tidelands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to PRC Section 6370.1 and is classified in a use category, Class C, which authorizes Multiple Use. Staff has coordinated this project with those agencies concerned with the use of this site and has determined that there will be no significant effect on the identified environmental values.

ALSO EXCEPTING THEREFROM any portion lying within the cable areas as shown on the above-mentioned nautical chart 18649.


