GENERAL PERMIT  
PUBLIC AGENCY USE

APPLICANT: County of Butte  
7 County Center Drive  
Oroville, California 95965

AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION:  
0.41 acre parcel of submerged land in the  
bed of the Feather River at the City of  
Oroville, Butte County.

LAND USE: Construction and maintenance of a concrete  
bridge on Table Mountain Boulevard.

TERMS OF PROPOSED PERMIT:  
Initial period: 49 years from October 1,  
1979.

CONSIDERATION: The public use and benefit, with the State  
reserving the right at any time to set  
a monetary rental if the Commission finds  
such action to be in the State's best interest.

PREREQUISITE TERMS, FEES AND EXPENSES:  
Applicant is permittee of upland.  
  
Filing fee and processing costs have been  
received.

STATUTORY AND OTHER REFERENCES:  
A. P.R.C.: Div. 6, Parts 1 & 2.  
B. Cal. Adm. Code: Title 2; Div. 3.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:  
1. The annual rental value of the site  
is estimated to be \$100.  
  
2. The County of Butte has obtained the  
necessary Right of Way on the North  
end of the bridge from the California  
Department of Water Resources and the  
Department of Fish and Game.

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The Right of Way on the South end of the bridge is expected to be obtained in fee from the upland owner. The property is currently going through probate, and the County anticipates settlement in the near future.

3. In order to assist the applicant in obtaining all authorized permits, staff is recommending that the Commission authorize issuance of the Permit subject to County acquiring the necessary Right of Way from the adjacent upland owner to the South prior to final issuance.
4. A final negative declaration was prepared by Butte County, pursuant to CEQA and implementing regulations. A Notice of Determination has been received.
5. This project is situated on State land identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370.1, and is classified in a use category, Class B, which authorizes Limited Use.

Staff has coordinated this project with those agencies and organizations which nominated the site as containing significant environmental values. They have found this project to be compatible with their nomination.

1. DETERMINE THAT AN EIR HAS NOT BEEN PREPARED FOR THIS PROJECT BUT THAT A NEGATIVE DECLARATION HAS BEEN PREPARED BY THE COUNTY OF BUTTE, ON DECEMBER 11, 1979.

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2. CERTIFY THAT THE COMMISSION HAS REVIEWED AND CONSIDERED THE INFORMATION CONTAINED IN THE NEGATIVE DECLARATION.
3. DETERMINE THAT THE PROJECT WILL NOT HAVE A SIGNIFICANT EFFECT ON THE ENVIRONMENT.
4. FIND THAT GRANTING OF THE PERMIT WILL HAVE NO SIGNIFICANT EFFECT UPON ENVIRONMENTAL CHARACTERISTICS IDENTIFIED PURSUANT TO SECTION 6370.1, OF THE P.R.C.
5. AUTHORIZE ISSUANCE TO THE COUNTY OF BUTTE OF A 49-YEAR GENERAL PERMIT - PUBLIC AGENCY USE FROM OCTOBER 1, 1979; IN CONSIDERATION OF THE PUBLIC USE AND BENEFIT; WITH THE STATE RESERVING THE RIGHT AT ANY TIME TO SET A MONETARY RENTAL IF THE COMMISSION FINDS SUCH ACTION TO BE IN THE STATE'S BEST INTEREST; FOR CONSTRUCTION AND MAINTENANCE OF A CONCRETE BRIDGE ON TABLE MOUNTAIN BOULEVARD ON THE LAND SHOWN ON EXHIBIT "A" ATTACHED AND BY REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF.



Table Mountain Boulevard  
Bridge Across Feather River

#### Description:

It is proposed to construct a new reinforced concrete bridge across the Feather River on Table Mountain Boulevard which connects the Thermalito area with downtown Oroville. This bridge will replace the existing steel truss structure and is proposed to be placed immediately upstream from the existing. It is proposed to leave the existing bridge in place and utilize it for bicycles and pedestrians. Construction of the bridge will require some work on the approaches but will utilize the existing roadway.

The area surrounding the project includes residences, some commercial property, the Feather River Fish Hatchery and the Feather River itself.

#### Determination:

An environmental study has been prepared by Butte County for the project. It has been determined that the overall project will not have a significant effect upon the environment for the following reasons:

1. There will be no significant change in the location or function of the existing roadway.
2. No changes are anticipated in the character or composition of traffic.
3. No living units, businesses or other structures will be removed and no persons will be displaced.
4. No schools, parks, recreational areas, or historical areas, will be adversely affected.
5. The project will not affect wildlife breeding feeding grounds.
