DREDGING PERMIT

In accordance with the Commission's delegation of authority to the Executive Officer on February 24, 1977, (Minute Item No. 32), to issue dredging permits of 10,000 cubic yards or less, to perform maintenance dredging on State-owned lands, the following applicant has been granted such permission:

The permit provides for dredging 5000 cubic yards of minerals other than oil, gas and geothermal from State-owned submerged lands in a lagoon occupying a portion of the last natural channel of the Colorado River near Needles, San Bernardino County. The purpose of the dredging is to restore the lagoon to navigable depth for operation of watercraft.

Dredged materials will be placed on a peninsula between the lagoon and the present river channel. All or part of the peninsula reportedly was created by the applicants' predecessor in title to the adjacent uplands, and it has been the subject of an unresolved title dispute with the State. As the boundary and extent of State ownership has not been determined, the permit contains special provisions concerning nonprejudice of claims and waiver of defenses. No royalty is assessed as the materials dredged will be deposited on lands to which the State may have a claim. The permit will be effective from April 1, 1980, through March 31, 1982.

In compliance with said delegation of authority, it has been determined that the following conditions have been met:

1. The proposed project is categorically exempt from the requirements of CEQA, pursuant to the provisions of Section 15104 of the CEQA Guidelines.


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2. Issuance of the permit and the resultant project will have no significant adverse effect on the environment or the environmental characteristics identified pursuant to Section 6370.1 et seq., of the P.R.C.
3. The dredging amount will not exceed 10,000 cubic yards.
4. A charge per cubic yard will be assessed for spoil material that is deposited on private property or otherwise lost to future State benefit.
5. Approval of the project will be contingent upon approval by all pertinent State, Federal and local agencies.


