FIFTH MODIFICATION OF THE
1980-1981 PLAN OF DEVELOPMENT
AND OPERATIONS AND BUDGET,
LONG BEACH UNIT,
WILMINGTON OIL FIELD, LOS ANGELES COUNTY

The City of Long Beach as Unit Operator, in accordance with provisions of Part IV, Section A.1., has requested approval of the Fifth Modification of the Plan of Development and Operations and Budget of the Long Beach Unit for the period July 1, 1980 through June 30, 1981.

This Fifth Modification would modify the Plan and the Budget to provide for recompleting two idle wells in other zones where economic operations are possible. To accomplish this work, \$350,000 would be transferred from Budget Item A.1.a. (2) Development Drilling, Ranger Zone to Budget Item A.1.c. (1) Other Well Work, Redrills (Other Zones).

Union Pacific-Ford Zone Well A-403 has not been economically productive since its completion as a new fault block test several years ago. It is believed that this well can be completed in the Upper Terminal Zone as a commercial well.

Union Pacific-Ford Zone well C-525 was idled as uneconomic with a fish in the hole in 1978. It should be possible to recover the fish to a sufficient depth to complete this well as an ideally located Ranger subzone injector.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION APPROVE THE FIFTH MODIFICATION OF THE PLAN OF DEVELOPMENT AND OPERATIONS AND BUDGET, LONG BEACH UNIT, JULY 1, 1980 THROUGH JUNE 30, 1981.

In addition, in accordance to Part IV.A.4.c. of the Plan, the approval of Plan Supplement No. 5 is hereby reported. This Plan Supplement provides capacity for future utility services to Island Grissom via the jetty of the Downtown Shoreline Marina.

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
