AUTHORIZATION TO FILE AN INDEMNITY SELECTION ON 9,000
ACRES OF FEDERAL LAND NEAR JUNCTION CITY, TRINITY COUNTY

In January 1979, the Commission authorized filing an indemnity selection on the entire Trinity Planning Unit in Trinity County consisting of 44,000 acres. Subsequent to this authorization, staff investigation disclosed that because of title problems caused mainly by unpatented mining claims and other potential management problems that only a portion of the Unit should be selected.

It appears that a 9,000-acre block of Bureau of Land Management land about 15 miles west of Weaverville is the most desirable land within the Unit. This block of land contains up to 150,000,000 board feet of merchantable timber, has developed access roads and is adjacent to an existing parcel of State school land.


