GENERAL PERMIT - RIGHT-OF-WAY USE

APPLICANT: Continental Telephone Company
of California
P. O. Box 992
Manteca, California 95336

AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION:
A 0.092-acre parcel of submerged lands
in the Merced River near Snelling, Merced
County.

LAND USE: Construction, operation and maintenance
of telephone and telegraph facilities.

TERMS OF PROPOSED PERMIT:
Special: Continuous use plus one
year from April 1, 1982.

CONSIDERATION: Exempt by law, Public Utilities Code 7901.

BASIS FOR CONSIDERATION:
Pursuant to 2 Cal. Adm. Code 2003 and
Public Utilities Code 7901.

PREREQUISITE TERMS, FEES AND EXPENSES:
Applicant is permittee of upland.

Filing fee and processing costs have been
received.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

1. The annual rental value of the site is estimated to be \$100.
2. An EIR is not required. This transaction is within the purview of 14 Cal. Adm. Code 15103, Class 3(d), which exempts new construction of small structures.
3. This project is situated on State land identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370.1, and is classified in a use category "Class B", which authorizes Limited Use. The project as proposed will not have a significant effect upon the identified environmental values.

APPROVALS REQUIRED:

This facility is subject to the jurisdiction of the United States Army Corps of Engineers, California Department of Fish and Game, California Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board, California Reclamation Board and the County of Merced. The proposed permit is conditioned on the approval of all agencies having jurisdiction.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION:

1. DETERMINE THAT AN ENVIRONMENTAL DOCUMENT HAS NOT BEEN PREPARED FOR THIS ACTIVITY AS SUCH DOCUMENT IS NOT REQUIRED UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF P.R.C. 21084, 14 CAL. ADM. CODE 15100 ET SEQ., AND 2 CAL. ADM. CODE 2905; AND FIND THAT THE PROJECT IS CONSISTENT WITH ITS USE CLASSIFICATION.
2. AUTHORIZE ISSUANCE TO CONTINENTAL TELEPHONE COMPANY OF CALIFORNIA OF A CONTINUOUS USE PLUS ONE YEAR GENERAL PERMIT - RIGHT-OF-WAY USE FROM APRIL 1, 1982, WHICH IS EXEMPT FROM CONSIDERATION PURSUANT TO PUBLIC UTILITIES CODE 7901; FOR CONSTRUCTION, OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF TELEPHONE AND TELEGRAPH FACILITIES OVER, ACROSS AND UNDER THE LAND DESCRIBED ON EXHIBIT "A" ATTACHED AND BY REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF.

EXHIBIT "A"

LAND DESCRIPTION

W 22804

A parcel of submerged land 10 feet wide in the Merced River in the NW-1/4 of the NE-1/4 of Section 10, T5S, R14E, MDM, lying 5 feet on each side of the following described centerline:

COMMENCING at the southwest corner of said Section 10, thence the following nine courses:

1. N 00° 33' E 3342.24 feet;
2. N 52° 14' E 953.04 feet;
3. N 52° 46' E 996.27 feet;
4. N 64° 37' E 411.25 feet;
5. N 78° 54' E 475.002 feet;
6. N 61° 09' E 317.064 feet;
7. South 179.60 feet;
8. N 63° 30' E 295 feet, and
9. N 83° 05' E 110 feet more or less to the POINT OF BEGINNING; thence N 30° 38' E 415 feet to the end of the herein described centerline.

EXCEPTING THEREFROM any portion lying landward of the ordinary low water mark of the Merced River.


