DREDGING PERMIT

In accordance with the Commission's delegation of authority to the Executive Officer for the issuance of dredging permits of 10,000 cubic yards or less, Minute Item 32, February 24, 1977, permission was granted to perform maintenance dredging on State-owned lands to the following party:

APPLICANT: Southwest Marina, Inc.
P. O. Box 13308
San Diego, California 92113

The permit provides for dredging 5000 cubic yards of material from granted tide and submerged lands in San Diego Bay, San Diego County. The purpose of the dredging is to restore usable berthing depth at applicant's ship repair facility.

Dredged materials will be spoiled on an EPA approved upland public disposal area. The permit provides for payment of a royalty of \$0.15 per cubic yard for material placed in a publicly-owned disposal area; \$0.25 per cubic yard in the event material is sold or placed on private property. The permit will be effective through June 30, 1983.

In compliance with said delegation of authority, it has been determined that the following conditions have been met:

1. The proposed project is categorically exempt from the requirements of CEQA, pursuant to the provisions of Section 15104 of the CEQA Guidelines.
2. Issuance of the permit and the resultant project will have no significant adverse effect on the environment or the environmental characteristics identified pursuant to Section 6370.1 et seq., of the P.R.C.
3. The dredging amount will not exceed 10,000 cubic yards.




4. A charge per cubic yard will be assessed for spoil material that is deposited on private property or otherwise lost to future State benefit.
5. Approval of the project will be contingent upon approval by all pertinent State, federal and local agencies.

5000 Cubic yards of granular material, via Clam Shell.





EXHIBIT "A"
