REPORT ON CURRENT STATUS OF  
PROPOSED PT. CONCEPTION/PT. ARGUELLO  
OIL AND GAS LEASING PROGRAM

In Calendar Items 20 and 21 on September 23, 1982, the Commission approved and certified the Final Environmental Impact Report (FEIR 308) and considered preliminary tract selection for the oil and gas leasing program. The Commission directed staff to seek public comment on the tract selection and leasing proposals. As directed, the Executive Officer held a public hearing in Santa Barbara on October 4, 1982. In addition, the Executive Officer met with a number of oil companies concerning the tracts and lease options. During the period since the September Commission meeting the Biological Survey (Benthic Characterization Study) has been reviewed by a six member scientific advisory panel. The study was available to the public on October 25 and several responses have been received.

The results of all these efforts are contained in a separate staff report to the Commission.
