DREDGING PERMIT

APPLICANT: Bureau of Electricity  
Department of Public Utilities  
City of Alameda  
P.O. Box 2860  
Alameda, California 94501

AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION:  
Tide and submerged lands owned by the State  
with minerals reserved in the Oakland-Alameda  
Estuary, Alameda County.

LAND USE: Dredge 30,000 cubic yards of sediments  
to prepare a channel for a 115 kilovolt  
electric cable system between the cities  
of Oakland and Alameda. Excavated materials  
will be removed to authorized disposal  
sites, one at Alcatraz Disposal Site S.F. 11  
and the other site for contaminated sediments  
will be at an authorized upland disposal  
site.

A royalty of \$0.15 per cubic yard will  
be charged for spoils disposed of at the  
C.O.E. Disposal Site (Alcatraz). A royalty  
of \$0.25 per cubic yard will be charged  
for spoils placed on private property or  
sold commercially.

PREREQUISITE TERMS, FEES AND EXPENSES:  
Filing fee has been received.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

1. The City of Alameda has completed an environmental assessment of the project and determined it to be categorically exempt as a negligible expansion of capacity. The City of Alameda has filed a Notice of Exemption dated October 12, 1982 with the Secretary of Resources.
2. Issuance of the permit and the resultant project will have no significant adverse effect on the environment or the environmental characteristics identified pursuant to Section 6370.1 et. seq. of the P.R.C.
3. Dredging amount is limited to 30,000 cubic yards.
4. Approval of the project will be contingent upon approval by all responsible State, Federal and local agencies.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION:

1. DETERMINE THAT AN ENVIRONMENTAL DOCUMENT HAD NOT BEEN PREPARED FOR THIS ACTIVITY AS SUCH DOCUMENT IS NOT REQUIRED UNDER PROVISIONS OF P.R.C. 21084, 14 CAL ADM CODE 15102(c) (CATEGORICAL EXEMPTIONS).
2. AUTHORIZE THE STAFF OF THE STATE LANDS COMMISSION TO ISSUE TO THE CITY OF ALAMEDA, BUREAU OF ELECTRICITY THE DREDGING PERMIT ON FILE IN THE OFFICES OF THE COMMISSION: SAID PERMIT SHALL BE ISSUED IN CONSIDERATION OF A ROYALTY OF \$0.15 PER CUBIC YARD TO BE CHARGED




FOR SPOILS DISPOSED OF IN THE CORPS OF ENGINEERS DISPOSAL SITE S.F. 11 AT ALCATRAZ AND A ROYALTY OF \$0.25 PER CUBIC YARD TO BE CHARGED FOR SPOILS PLACED ON A PRIVATELY OWNED DISPOSAL SITE OR SOLD FOR COMMERCIAL BENEFIT. SAID PERMIT SHALL BE FOR A PERIOD OF ONE YEAR BEGINNING DECEMBER 1, 1982 AND, SHALL ALLOW THE DREDGING OF A MAXIMUM OF 30,000 CUBIC YARDS OF MINERALS OTHER THAN OIL, GAS AND GEOTHERMAL FROM AN AREA OF TIDELANDS AT THE OAKLAND-ALAMEDA, ALAMEDA COUNTY, CALIFORNIA, SAID AREA IS SHOWN IN EXHIBIT "A" ATTACHED HERETO AND BY THIS REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF. THE MATERIAL DREDGED SHALL BE DEPOSITED IN DISPOSAL SITES APPROVED BY ALL APPLICABLE REGULATORY AGENCIES. THE COMPLETE PERMIT IS CONTAINED IN FILE PRC 5718, LOCATED IN THE COMMISSION OFFICE.

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

PLAN




PROFILE


