DREDGING PERMIT

APPLICANT: City and County of San Francisco
Department of Recreation and Parks
Department of Public Works
45 Hyde Street, Room 204
San Francisco, California 94102

AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION: Tide and submerged lands in the Marina,
Small Craft Harbor, San Francisco Bay.

LAND USE: To dredge and place five cubic yards of
dislodged riprap back onto adjacent banks
and remove 450 cubic yards of sediments
from the Marina and dispose of it at the
United States Army Corps of Engineers Spoils
Disposal Site San Francisco 11 near Alcatraz
Island.

TERMS OF PROPOSED PERMIT:
Initial period: Five years from January 1,
1983.

CONSIDERATION: A royalty of \$0.15 per cubic yard is to
be charged for spoils deposited in the
United States Army Corps of Engineers Disposal
Site San Francisco 11 located near Alcatraz
Island in San Francisco Bay. A royalty
of \$0.25 per cubic yard is to be charged
for spoils placed on private property or
sold for commercial benefit. No royalty
to be charged for spoils placed on publicly
owned lands.

PREREQUISITE TERMS, FEES AND EXPENSES:
The filing fee has been received.

STATUTORY AND OTHER REFERENCES:

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:
1. The project is exempt under CEQA Guidelines 14 Cal. Adm. Code 15104(g). The project is maintenance dredging with authorized disposal of spoils.
2. All necessary application requirements have been fulfilled.
3. This project is situated on State lands identified as possessing significant environmental value pursuant to P.R.C. 6370.1, and is classified in a use category class "C", Multiple Use. Staff has coordinated this project with those agencies and organizations which nominated the site as containing significant environmental values. They have found this project to be compatible with their nomination.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION:

1. DETERMINE THAT AN ENVIRONMENTAL DOCUMENT HAS NOT BEEN PREPARED FOR THIS ACTIVITY AS SUCH DOCUMENT IS NOT REQUIRED UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF P.R.C. 21084, 14 CAL. ADM. CODE 15100 ET SEQ., AND 2 CAL. ADM. CODE 2905, AND FIND THAT THIS ACTIVITY IS COMPATIBLE WITH THE LAND USE CLASSIFICATION ASSIGNED UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF P.R.C. 6370 ET SEQ.

2. AUTHORIZE ISSUANCE TO THE CITY OF SAN FRANCISCO OF A FIVE-YEAR DREDGING PERMIT FROM JANUARY 1, 1983, IN CONSIDERATION OF A ROYALTY OF \$0.15 PER CUBIC YARD TO BE CHARGED FOR SPOILS DISPOSED OF AT THE UNITED STATES ARMY CORPS OF ENGINEERS DISPOSAL SITE SAN FRANCISCO 11 NEAR ALCATRAZ ISLAND IN SAN FRANCISCO BAY AND A ROYALTY OF \$0.25 PER CUBIC YARD TO BE CHARGED FOR SPOILS PLACED ON PRIVATE PROPERTY OR SOLD FOR COMMERCIAL BENEFIT. NO ROYALTY CHARGED FOR SPOILS PLACED ON PUBLICLY OWNED LANDS.





