OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

1. The activities listed on Exhibit "A" are exempt from CEQA because they involve existing facilities, Items 3,4,5,6,7,8,9,10, 11,12, and 13, reconstruction of existing facilities, Item 2, or new construction of a small structure, Item 1.
Authority: Cal. Adm. Code, Title 2, Div. 3, Section 2905, Class 1, 2, and 3.
2. The individual projects listed on Exhibit "A" are situated on State land identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370.1, and are classified in use categories, Class "B", Items 1,2,3,4 and 7 through 13, which authorizes Limited Use, or Class "C", Items 5 and 6, which authorizes Multiple Use. The projects as proposed will not have a significant effect upon identified environmental values.
3. Items 5 and 6 are Huntington Harbour activities situated on land identified as possessing environmental values in that the State Lands Commission stated all waterways under the Commission's jurisdiction have environmental significance. Staff finds these projects to be compatible with Commission policy.
4. Lake Tahoe Application: The Commission at its meeting on November 27, 1978, suspended all leasing for new construction at Lake Tahoe, except for mooring buoys in designated areas. This action was taken pending completion of an EIR which addresses the cumulative impact of continued construction of piers in Lake Tahoe. Items 2,4, and 8 through 13 herein are for the continued use of existing piers in the lake, and therefore are not subject to the Commission's suspension of leasing activities for new construction.

5. All permits covering structures in Lake Tahoe will include a condition subsequent that if any structure authorized is found to be in nonconformance with the Tahoe Regional Planning Agency's Shorezone ordinance and if any alterations, repairs, or removal required pursuant to said ordinance are not accomplished within the designated time period, then the permit will be automatically terminated, effective upon notice by the State and the site shall be cleared pursuant to the terms thereof.

1. DETERMINE THAT EIRS HAVE NOT BEEN PREPARED FOR ITEMS 1 THROUGH 13, EXCEPT ITEMS 5 AND 6, OF EXHIBIT "A" AS SUCH REPORTS ARE NOT REQUIRED UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF P.R.C. 21084, 14 CAL. ADM. CODE 15300, ET SEQ., AND 2 CAL. ADM. CODE 2905, AND FIND THAT THESE PROJECTS ARE CONSISTENT WITH THE LAND'S USE CLASSIFICATIONS PURSUANT TO PRC 6370.1.
2. AUTHORIZE THE ISSUANCE OF TEN-YEAR RECREATIONAL PIER PERMITS TO THE APPLICANTS LISTED IN EXHIBIT "A" ATTACHED AND BY REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF.


