A Geophysical Turning Permit for the period
June 1, 1984 through August 31, 1984, allowing
Permittee to turn in State waters while
conducting surveys on outer continental shelf
(OCS) lands provided that acoustic pulse
generating equipment is not operated during
turning operations and that all terms and
conditions of the permit, including required
notices specified therein, are fully complied
with.


- A. Map of permit regions.

1. FIND THAT THE ACTIVITY IS EXEMPT FROM REQUIREMENTS OF THE CEQA PURSUANT TO 14 CAL. ADM. CODE 15061(b)(3) BECAUSE THERE IS NO POSSIBILITY THAT IT MAY HAVE A SIGNIFICANT EFFECT ON THE ENVIRONMENT.
2. AUTHORIZE ISSUANCE TO CHEVRON USA, INC., A NON-EXCLUSIVE GENERAL PERMIT TO CONDUCT GEOPHYSICAL TURNING OPERATION FOR THE PERIOD JUNE 1, 1984 THROUGH AUGUST 31, 1984.
