CUMULATIVE EFFECTS OF ALL EXISTING AND PROPOSED MARINA DEVELOPMENT  
IN THE GREATER SACRAMENTO AREA

PURSUANT TO THE COMMISSION DIRECTION AT THE JULY 12, 1984 MEETING, STAFF HAS COMPLETED THE FOLLOWING:

1. IMPOSED A MORATORIUM ON PROPOSED NEW COMMERCIAL/INDUSTRIAL FACILITIES, AND PROPOSED EXPANSION OF EXISTING COMMERCIAL/INDUSTRIAL FACILITIES ON THE SACRAMENTO RIVER SOUTH TO WALNUT GROVE, AND NORTH TO VERONA.
2. ADVISED ALL AGENCIES HAVING JURISDICTION OVER SOME FACET OF RIVER DEVELOPMENT OF THE NEED FOR A STUDY OF CUMULATIVE EFFECTS.

INVITED REPRESENTATIVES FROM ALL AFFECTED AGENCIES TO DISCUSS FUTURE RIVER DEVELOPMENT, AND SET THE COURSE AND SCOPE OF THE STUDY. WE ANTICIPATE HOLDING THE DISCUSSION DURING AN INSPECTION TRIP SCHEDULED FOR SEPTEMBER 20, 1984.
