EXECUTIVE OFFICER'S REPORT JANUARY 31, 1985

DREDGING PERMIT

W 23538 PRC 6768

IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE COMMISSION'S DELEGATION OF AUTHORITY
TO THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER FOR THE ISSUANCE OF DREDGING PERMITS
OF 10,000 CUBIC YARDS OR LESS, PERMISSION WAS GRANTED ON JANUARY
25, 1985 TO EXCAVATE 10,000 CUBIC YARDS OF MATERIAL FROM GRANTED
LANDS TO THE APPLICANT. BECAUSE OF SILTATION AND TIME DIFFICULTY,
THE APPLICANT REQUESTED AND THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER ISSUED AN
SEMERGENCY LETTER OF PERMISSION FOR THE SOUTH BAY BOAT YARD IN
SAN DIEGO.

THIS LETTER OF PERMISSION ALLOWS IMMEDIATE DREDGING OF A LARGER PROJECT FOR WHICH A DREDGING PERMIT FOR THE TOTAL VOLUME OF 44,500 CUBIC YARDS WILL BE ISSUED. THIS LETTER OF PERMISSION SPECIFIES THAT ALL OTHER TERMS, CONDITIONS AND REQUIREMENTS OF THE LATER PERMIT WILL APPLY TO THIS LETTER OF PERMISSION AND REQUIRES COMPLIANCE WITH THE PERMITS, RECOMMENDATIONS AND LIMITATIONS OF ALL APPLICABLE FEDERAL, STATE AND LOCAL AGENCIES.

THE APPLICANT IS REQUESTING THIS EMERGENCY DREDGING TO ALLOW IMMEDIATE STARTUP OF THE PROJECT UNTIL THE FINAL PERMIT FOR THE ENTIRE 44,500 CUBIC YARD AMOUNT CAN BE ISSUED AT THE FEBRUARY COMMISSION MEETING.

SPOILS ARE TO BE PLACED AT THE EPA APPROVED DISPOSAL SITE L.A. 3 WITH A ROYALTY OF \$0.15 PER CUBIC YARD FOR DISPOSAL AND A ROYALTY OF \$0.25 PER CUBIC YARD FOR SPOILS PLACED ON PRIVATE PROPERTY OR SOLD FOR COMMERCIAL BENEFIT.

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
