GENERAL PERMIT - CITY OF HUNTINGTON BEACH W 23550 PRC 6853

AT ITS MEETING OF JUNE 26, 1985, THE COMMISSION AUTHORIZED THE ISSUANCE OF A CENERAL PERMIT - PUBLIC AGENCY USE TO THE CITY OF HUNTINGTON BEACH FOR A PUBLIC POCK IN THE HUNTINGTON HARBOUR MAIN CHANNEL, SUBJECT TO VERIFICATION BY THE DEPARTMENT OF CENERAL SERVICES THAT THE REQUIRED PUBLIC LIABILITY INSURANCE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$100,000 WAS ADEQUATE FOR THE FACILITY. STAFF DID CONTACT A REPRESENTATIVE OF THE DEPARTMENT OF GENERAL SERVICES WHO RECOMMENDED LIABILITY INSURANCE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,000,060. THE LEASE HAS BEEN MODIFIED TO REFLECT THE INCREASE.

ADDITION OF PIER TO PUBLIC AGENCY PERMIT, SEVEN HILE SLOUGH, SACRAMENTO COUNTY

THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF PARKS AND RECREATION, AN EXISTING PERMITTEE, HAS SUBMITTED AN APPLICATION TO CONSTRUCT AN 8' X 60' FIGHING PIER IN SEVEN MILE SLOUGH AT BRANHAN ISLAND STATE FARK.

THE APPLICANT HAS ALSO REQUESTED A LUTTER OF ADVANCE PERMISSION TO ASSURE EARLY COMMENCEMENT OF THE WORK. WITH YOUR APPROVAL I WILL ISSUE THE REQUESTED LETTER, SINCE NORMAL PROCESSING OF THE AMENDMENT WOULD RUN BEYOND THE START OF CONSTRUCTION.

THE WORK IS CATEGORICALLY EXEMPT FROM CEQA AND THE APPLICANT HAS CLEARANCES FROM ALL OTHER JURISDICTIONS.
