ASSIGNMENT OF A GENERAL PERMIT --
PROTECTIVE STRUCTURE USE

APPLICANT: Montgomery Equipment Company
PO Box 2508
Bakersfield, CA 93303

ASSIGNEE: Bracton Corporation
100 Spear Street, 10th Floor
San Francisco, CA 94105

AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION:
A 0.147-acre parcel of tide and submerged land
in the Pacific Ocean at Carpinteria,
Santa Barbara County.

LAND USE: Protective Seawall.

TERMS OF ORIGINAL PERMIT:

Initial period: Ten years beginning
January 1, 1980.

Public liability insurance: Combined single
limit coverage of \$100,000.

Consideration: \$384 per annum; five-year
rent review.

APPLICANT STATUS:

Applicant is owner of upland.

PREREQUISITE CONDITIONS, FEES AND EXPENSES:

Processing costs have been received.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

1. On December 27, 1985 by Grant Deed, Lessee transferred the upland property at the site of the subject seawall to Bracton Corporation. Lessee now wishes to assign the protective structure permit for the seawall to Bracton Corporation and Bracton has agreed to accept the permit assignment.
2. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370, et seq. but will not affect those significant lands.
3. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (14 Cal. Adm. Code 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA because the activity is not a "project" as defined by CEQA and the State CEQA Guidelines.

Authority: P.R.C. 21065 and 14 Cal. Adm. Code 15378.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION:

1. FIND THAT THE ACTIVITY IS EXEMPT FROM THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE CEQA PURSUANT TO 14 CAL. ADM. CODE 15061 BECAUSE THE ACTIVITY IS NOT A PROJECT AS DEFINED BY P.R.C. 21065 AND 14 CAL. ADM. CODE 15378.
2. FIND THAT THIS ACTIVITY WILL INVOLVE LANDS IDENTIFIED AS POSSESSING SIGNIFICANT ENVIRONMENTAL VALUES PURSUANT TO P.R.C. 6370, ET SEQ., BUT THAT SUCH ACTIVITY WILL HAVE NO DIRECT OR INDIRECT EFFECT ON SUCH LANDS.

3. AUTHORIZE ISSUANCE OF AN ASSIGNMENT OF LEASE PRC 5764, ON FILE IN THE PRINCIPAL OFFICE OF THE STATE LANDS COMMISSION, TO BRACON CORPORATION EFFECTIVE JUNE 30, 1987, ALL TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF PRC 5764 REMAIN UNCHANGED AND IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT ON THE LAND DESCRIBED ON EXHIBIT "A" ATTACHED AND BY REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF.

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
