GENERAL PERMIT - PUBLIC AGENCY USE

APPLICANT: California Department of Fish and Game
Attn: John J. Grant

AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION:
15+ acre parcel of tide and submerged land in
the Pacific Ocean near Pacific Palisades,
Los Angeles County.

LAND USE: Artificial kelp reef.

TERMS OF PROPOSED PERMIT:
Initial period: 20 years beginning October 1,
1987.

CONSIDERATION: The public use and benefit; with the State
reserving the right at any time to set a
monetary rental if the Commission finds such
action to be in the State's best interest.

BASIS FOR CONSIDERATION:
Pursuant to 2 Cal. Adm. Code 2003.

PREREQUISITE CONDITIONS, FEES AND EXPENSES:
Filing fee and processing costs have been
received.

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OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

1. In order to minimize the effects of increased utilization of living marine resources and to compensate for degradation of the marine environment caused by the increased use of the nearshore waters, the Department of Fish and Game (DFG) has been conducting studies involving artificial reefs. The studies involve:
 - a. Construction of fishing reefs to increase shelter, forage, breeding and nursery areas for fish, invertebrates and plants; and
 - b. Determination of what role the reefs play in nearshore ecosystems and whether the reefs could be useful in mitigating the effects of industrial development. As part of these studies, the DFG proposes to construct an experimental reef in the Pacific Ocean near Pacific Palisades. This reef, designed to grow kelp, will provide the basis for a potential tool for mitigating kelp habitat loss. It will also provide enhanced recreational opportunities for fishing and sport diving.
2. The annual rental value of the site is estimated to be \$4,271.
3. This activity involves lands identified as possessing significant environmental values pursuant to P.R.C. 6370, et seq. and the project, as proposed, is consistent with its use classification.
4. Pursuant to the Commission's delegation of authority and the State CEQA Guidelines (14 Cal. Adm. Code 15061), the staff has determined that this activity is exempt from the requirements of the CEQA as a categorical exempt project. The project is exempt under Class 4, Minor Alteration to Land, 14 Cal. Adm. Code 15304.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION:

1. FIND THAT THE ACTIVITY IS EXEMPT FROM THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE CEQA PURSUANT TO 14 CAL. ADM. CODE 15061 AS A CATEGORICAL EXEMPT PROJECT, CLASS 4; MINOR ALTERATION TO LAND, 14 CAL. ADM. CODE 15304.
2. FIND THAT THIS ACTIVITY IS CONSISTENT WITH THE USE CLASSIFICATION DESIGNATED FOR THE LAND PURSUANT TO P.R.C. 6370, ET SEQ.
3. AUTHORIZE ISSUANCE TO THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF FISH AND GAME OF A 20-YEAR GENERAL PERMIT - PUBLIC AGENCY USE BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 1987; IN CONSIDERATION OF THE PUBLIC USE AND BENEFIT, WITH THE STATE RESERVING THE RIGHT AT ANY TIME TO SET A MONETARY RENTAL IF THE COMMISSION FINDS SUCH ACTION TO BE IN THE STATE'S BEST INTEREST; FOR AN ARTIFICIAL KELP REEF ON THE LAND DESCRIBED ON EXHIBIT "A" ATTACHED AND BY REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF.

EXHIBIT "A"
LAND DESCRIPTION

W 24023

A parcel of sovereign land of the State of California, approximately 0.6 nautical miles southwest of the coastline at Pacific Palisades, in the Pacific Ocean, Santa Monica Bay, Los Angeles County, California, more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at Point "A", having California Coordinates System Zone 7, Coordinates of X=4,124,911.38 feet, Y=4,121,565.05 feet, thence from said point of beginning the following four (4) courses:

1. S 54°06'42" E, 1556.20 feet;
2. S 32°05'54" W, 476.71 feet;
3. N 51°12'18" W, 1617.39 feet;
4. N 39°53'53" E, 394.62 feet to the point of beginning.

Coordinates, bearing and distances used in the above parcel are based on the California Coordinate System, Zone 7, 1927 N.A.D.

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
